Invitation Letter

The annual meeting invitation letter from Executive Director Dave Fellers, CAE, is for healthcare professionals who need to apply for a visa in order to attend RSNA 2006. There are two ways to personalize a letter:

- 1) Print a letter from your computer by visiting our Web site at rsna2006.rsna.org. Go to international.
- 2) Request a mailed letter via reginfo@rsna.org. Include your name, as it appears on your passport, and your mailing address.

Traveling to the United States

All visa applicants are advised to apply for their visas as soon as travel to the United States is contemplated, and not later than 3–4 months in advance. This means that international delegates should **start the visa process during July–August**.

Visa Waiver Program

All travelers under the Visa Waiver Program (VWP) must have a machine-readable passport to travel to the United States without a visa.

US-VISIT

US-VISIT applies to all visitors holding non-immigrant visas, regardless of country or origin. Visitors are photographed and fingerprinted upon

arrival. The quick and efficient processes take a few seconds in most cases. Goals of the program are to enhance the security of citizens and visitors, as well as facilitate legitimate travel and trade.
